












<p><i>Rosa</i> 'Climbing America™' Large-flowered Rose</p>	<p>Large coral-pink flowers of densely overlapping petals paired with an intense, spicy fragrance. 4-5" cupped blooms occur individually, and in small clusters, on wood, new and old. A vigorous and free-flowering plant with dark green foliage. This climbing rose is one of the few, of this type, to achieve AARS award-winning status.</p>	<p>H 8-10' W 4-6' Zone 4</p>

<p><i>Rosa</i> 'Climbing Royal Gold' Large-flowered Rose</p>	<p>Daffodil-yellow 4-5" cupped blooms with a moderately sweet honey fragrance. Free flowering, borne individually or in clusters of 3-7. Large, glossy dark-green foliage. Long stems make these suitable for cuttings.</p>	<p>H 5-7' W 5' Zone 4</p>	
<p><u>Floribunda/Grandiflora Roses</u></p>			
<p><i>Rosa floribunda</i> 'Intrigue' Floribunda Rose (Bushy)</p>	<p>Unique dark wine-colored buds on long elegant stems open to 3" high-centered plum-purple blooms. An intense lemon fragrance wafts from these beautiful roses. Upright, bushy habit.</p>	<p>H 3-4' W 2-3' Zone 4</p>	
<p><i>Rosa floribunda</i> 'Living Easy' Floribunda Rose (Bushy)</p>	<p>The foliage is so glossy green and free from black spot that the bush looks great even without flowers. But you won't have much of an opportunity to see just leaves 'cause it blooms up a storm. Scrumptious flowers of showy apricot orange will light up your landscape. Releases a light fruity fragrance. Large dark green foliage and an upright, vigorous habit. Performs well in the heat. Disease resistant. <p><i>Rosa</i> 'Bonica®' Shrub Rose</p>	<p>Large clusters of 2.5" candy-pink double blooms on arching branches over mild green foliage. Continual bloomer, disease resistant. Plant in full sun to partial shade. Likes to grow in sufficiently moist, well-drained soil.</p>	<p>H 4-5' W 4' Zone 4</p>	
<p><i>Rosa</i> 'Iceberg' Floribunda Rose Shrub Rose</p>	<p>One of the top ten roses in the world. Extremely disease-resistant and a vigorous grower. Long, pointed buds and crisp white flowers. Dark green foliage. Plant in full sun although shade tolerant, likes moist soil.</p>	<p>H 3-5' W 2' Zone 5</p>	
<p><i>Rosa</i> 'Icecap' Shrub Rose</p>	<p>Displays a dense flush of pure white flowers on a compact, rounded shrub. It has excellent repeat-blooming and disease resistance in the landscape.</p>	<p>H 2.5 W 3.5 Zone 4</p>	<p>Photo Credit Star Roses</p> 
<p><i>Rosa</i> 'Miracle on the Hudson®' Shrub Rose</p>	<p>Large semi-double red blossoms, up to 4", with mild fragrance, group in clusters. New growth foliage begins as red, maturing to dark green. <p><i>Rosa</i> 'Morden Centennial' Shrub Rose</p>	<p>Flowers all season with especially profuse flushes of rich pink flowers at beginning and end. The lightly scented blooms appear in clusters among healthy, disease-resistant foliage followed by persistent red hips.</p>	<p>H 3-5' W 3-5' Zone 3</p>	
<p><i>Rosa</i> 'Morden Sunrise' Shrub Rose</p>	<p>This Parkland series rose has dark foliage with improved resistance to blackspot. The creamy orange-yellow buds open to fragrant flowers with wavy petals and orange stamens. As they age, the color matures from dark orange over yellow, to light orange with bright yellow, to creamy yellow with white. Own root.</p>	<p>H 2-3' W 2-3' Zone 3</p>	
<p><i>Rosa</i> 'Pink Miracle' Shrub Rose</p>	<p>Abundant pink partner of the marvelous Miracle on the Hudson. Deep glossy green leaves provide the perfect background for vibrant hot pink semi-double blooms. Like its partner, the plant is bushy, full & beautiful...well-worthy of every landscape.</p>	<p>H 3-4' W 3-4' Zone 4</p>	
<p><i>Rosa</i> 'Pretty Polly Pink' Shrub Rose</p>	<p>Pink, Polyantha Rose with very good disease resistance and exceptional flowering from spring through fall. It is attractively compact in the landscape.</p>	<p>H 2.5' W 3' Zone 4</p>	<p>Photo Credit Star Nursery</p>

<p><i>Rosa hybrida</i> 'Winnipeg Parks' Shrub Rose</p>	<p>Small clusters of deep pinkish-red and open to dark cherry-pink flowers. The slightly fragrant flowers with matte green foliage that takes on a reddish tinge in fall. With a bonus of red hips, this compact, low-growing rose is a beauty.
